Common questions regard the Service- Talent Bank:

1) Must I stay available if I put down that I am free most evening?

No. Go about your regular schedule. Only when you are ready, willing and able will you be contacted. Only the Deacon who contacts you will know you have been called.

2) Will I be overworked?

Every effort will be made to spread the duties around. A record will be kept of how often you have been contacted, in order to avoid overloading any one person. Only the Officers and the Office staff will know who is on the list.
